One of the pillars of the chamber music repertoire, Schubert composed 'Death and the Maiden' in 1824, after he suffered a serious illness and realised that he was dying. It is named for the theme of the second movement, referring to a song Schubert wrote in 1817 of the same title. Uniquely among Schubert's quartets, all of its movements are written in minor keys.
